

Ferenc Tóth (PhD 1995, DSc 2014) is a Senior Research Fellow (Scientific Counsellor) at the Institute of History, Research Centre for the Humanities, Hungarian Academy of Sciences and researcher of MTA BTK Lendület Integrating Families Research Group (2017–2022), in which he continues his doctoral researches on Hungarian-French families of the Hungarian immigration into France during the 18th century. His other areas of research are the history of French-Hungarian connexions in the early modern period, military history, diplomatic history, social and cultural history. His responsibilities include coordinating relations with French, Francophone and Polish research groups and performing new research on early modern ego-histories (for ex.: the new scientific editions of Francis Rákóczi's Confession). He has organized more than ten international conferences. Ferenc Tóth has been the recipient of the academic prizes of the MTA Bolyai Scholarship (2001), the Prize „Researcher of the Year” of MTA VEAB Committee (2005) and the Prize „Géza Perjés” (2007). He often published articles in international journals such as the *Revue d'histoire diplomatique* and the *Revue internationale d'histoire militaire*. His list of publications includes several monographs (in French and Hungarian) and text editions, edited volumes and numerous articles and chapters in peer-reviewed international journals and collection of studies. For example, he has published *Un diplomate militaire français en Europe orientale à la fin de l'ancien régime. François de Tott (1733-1793)*. (Istanbul: Isis, 2011), and edited recently the *Journal des campagnes de Charles de Lorraine* (Paris: Honoré Champion, 2017).
